## WSWQC 2016 Season Preview

**Good News!** Thanks to everyone who came to the Conservation Commission hearing for the Surface Water Ouality Committees proposed Aquatic Management Program for Dudley Pond. We have been granted a five-year Order of Conditions. The Plan proposes to continue our program to use diver hand pulling as the primary management tool, but allows for herbicide if necessary.

Bad News: As shown in our **2015 end of season weed survey** we have two problems: Tape Grass, and our old nemesis Eurasian Milfoil. We will be treating portions of the pond with fluridone (as we did in 2008) to manage the milfoil. Likely in late April you will see signs posting when the treatment will take place. No boating or swimming on the day of treatment please. When the signs come down you can swim again. Don't use pond water to irrigate your lawn or garden until the end of the season.

The fluridone may suppress the tape grass some – but we expect that in the late summer we will "give it a haircut" in places to keep it away from swimmers and boaters. Our new order of conditions allows this – our old one didn't

WSWQC thanks the DPA for its continuing support and offsetting 25% of the Town's expenses for Dudley Pond weed management. This sends the clear message to the town that Dudley Pond Association and its supporters are doing our part.
